## Stage One Concept Finalists

Lilly Endowment's Enhancing Opportunity in Indianapolis initiative seeks to fund efforts that help people overcome the challenges of poverty and financial insecurity. In the first stage of this initiative, 220 organizations submitted concept papers describing how their projects could help more Indianapolis (Marion County) residents make progress toward economic self-sufficiency. Now, in stage two, the Endowment is asking the following 36 organizations to submit full proposals.

The Endowment expects to award up to \$50 million in 2021 to fund the most promising proposals.
