Timeline and Budget Sample Templates

Although there is no required format for a proposal timeline or budget, the five samples below illustrate the type of information that could be useful and potential formats that applicants can consider. Applicants should develop timelines and budgets specific to their planned activities.

Timeline Sample One

Date(s)	Location	Activities	
4/1 - 5/15/23	Indianapolis, IN	6-week photography course	
5/28	Indianapolis, IN	Pick-up rental RV, grocery shop and pack	
5/28 - 6/2	Travel	Travel by RV to Yellowstone National Park	
6/2 - 6/6	Yellowstone National Park	Hike marked trails, participate in park program on park wildlife habitats, photograph sunrise, sunset, park features and wildlife, journal about experience each evening	
6/7	Travel	Travel to Glacier National Park	
6/7 - 6/11	Glacier National Park	Hike marked trails, participate in park program on park wildflowers, take park shuttle along "Goingto-the-Sun Road," photograph landscapes and park features, journal each evening	
6/11 - 6/12	Travel	Travel to Mount Rainier National Park, one overnight stop included	
6/12 - 6/17	Mount Rainier National Park	Participate in two-day volunteer experience on train maintenance. Leave RV for two nights of backcountry camping, photograph landscapes and primitive camping experience, journal each evening	

6/17 -6/22	Travel	Travel home to Indianapolis by RV. Take time while traveling to enjoy additional sites, stopping at landmarks, including: Grand Teton National Park, Badlands National Park and St. Louis Gateway Arch National Park
7/1 - 7/30	Indianapolis, IN	Review journal entries, edit photos, compile photographic journal to be printed and bound for display in classroom

Timeline Sample Two

Day 1:	Drive from Marion, IN to Kansas City, MO. Spend night with family.
Days 2-3:	Drive from Kansas City, MO to Boise, ID. Spend night in hotel.
Day 3:	Check in to Art of Living Retreat Center, settle into room, tour grounds, meet one-on-one with retreat guide.
Days 4 - 14:	Participate in 10-day meditation retreat, as described in project description.
Day 15:	Check out of Art of Living Retreat Center, visit camping supply store and grocery. Spend the night in hotel.
Days 16 - 20:	Travel to Arches National Park, camp, hike, journal and continue to refine meditative practices as described in project description.
Day 21:	Leave Arches, travel to Las Vegas for overnight stay, restocking on groceries and repacking equipment.
Day 22 - 26:	Travel to Joshua Tree National Park, camp, hike, journal and continue to refine meditative practices as described in project description.
Days 27 - 30:	Travel home, staying overnight in hotels.
