

Advancing Science of Reading in Indiana

December 2023

In 2023, Lilly Endowment approved 28 implementation grants to Indiana colleges and universities through its Advancing Science of Reading in Indiana (ASRI) initiative. The aim of the initiative is to improve significantly the reading abilities of Indiana K-12 students. It is designed to complement a statewide effort recently undertaken by the Indiana Department of Education (IDOE) to improve reading achievement in K-12 schools by helping current teachers implement Science of Reading-aligned methods in their classrooms.

Implementation grant amounts range from \$325,400 to \$1,500,000. The amounts are based on the fiveyear average of the number of Indiana licenses granted annually to graduates in early childhood education, elementary and/or special education.

All grantees are located in Indiana unless otherwise noted.
