In November 2025, Lilly Endowment approved 34 grants to help K-12 public and private schools, school districts and networks through the competitive third phase of the Marion County K-12 Schools Initiatives. The aim of the initiatives is to help K-12 schools initiate, enhance or expand compelling programs and projects that show promise to improve their students' academic achievement and prospects for post-secondary success.
